## LETTER FROM THE PRESIDENT

Dear Friends,

Veterinary specialisation in Europe is on the move and whilst the ESVD continues to be amongst the most active and innovative, there is a growing spirit of co-operation and collaboration between the specialist groups. This was fostered initially by meetings organised by the Working Party on Veterinary Specialisation and funded by the European Community via the European Association for Veterinary Specialisation. A Veterinary Specialisation Liaison Committee has grown out of these discussions and is enabling the specialist organisations to adopt a common approach on a pan-European basis.

In parallel with this process, the Advisory Committee on Veterinary Specialisation of the EC has organised a series of meetings, involving the presidents of the most developed specialities, designed to set high standards for Europe as a whole. Each of the specialities has in turn set up sub-committees to determine how these standards can be met and to create the organisations which will monitor them. This has led to the formation of Colleges which will be composed of members holding European Diplomas in each of the specialities. Procedures for the establishment of the Colleges, and the courses and examinations for the Diplomas, are defined in the Statutes and in the Information Brochures of the Colleges. The statutes of the proposed European College of Veterinary Dermatology have been circulated to all full members of the ESVD; they are available from the ESVD Secretary to all others who wish to receive them.

The ECVD statutes are closely similar in structure to those of the other European veterinary speciality Colleges, and are based on the format adopted by the American Colleges. The adoption of a similar format and a uniform approach has been deliberate and should facilitate political acceptance of the ideals, which we have put forward, amongst the different European states. However, for the time being, the status of the Colleges and their members is unofficial and will depend on voluntary acceptance by individual nations. National diplomas which are of equivalent standard to the European diplomas may be accepted by the Colleges but we intend that, ultimately, the European specialist diplomas will be the mark of the specialists throughout Europe.

The «ESVD Diploma» programme will continue but will be described as an advanced «Certificate» course. The title «Diploma» is being dropped to avoid confusion with the ECVD Diploma.

Collaboration and communication is also developing outside Europe as evidenced by our organisation, with our North American colleagues, of the Second World Congress of *Veterinary Dermatology* in Montréal (May 13-15, 1992), and the joint production, with the American College of

*Veterinary Dermatology*, of the journal *Veterinary Dermatology*, now in its third volume. Further information about ESVD publications and further education is given elsewhere in this Annual Report.

We look forward to our 1992 Annual Congress Which is being held on this occasion in conjunction with the WSAVA, in Rome (24th September, 1992). We planned a smaller Congress in 1992 to avoid competing too much with the World Congress in Canada. Early indications are that a large European contingent will attend in Montréal and this meeting promises to be most enjoyable and informative. The Rome Congress also has a very attractive programme and I hope that those who attend in Montréal will not feel that they cannot go to Rome; a very special Italian welcome awaits us all. Next year we will meet in Aalborg, Denmark, where our Danish members are planning an outstanding programme for our tenth anniversary celebrations.

As veterinary specialisation develops and matures in Europe, the ESVD itself is changing. During the past year we have voted to alter our electoral procedures, so that postal voting is now possible. Thus, for the first time, nominations and election to the new ESVD Board will be by mail and the results of the 1992 elections will be announced in Rome. Only full members are eligible to vote and we have urged associate members who devote much of their time to dermatology to apply for full membership and participate more fully in the development of the speciality. The strength of a society, such as ESVD, lies in the members and their active involvement. Attendance at meetings is an important part of this but you can also contribute at many different levels by writing papers and reports for *Veterinary Dermatology* and for the ESVD bulletin, and by assisting in the organisation and promotion of ESVD activities. Those with computers and modems can also take advantage of the facilities offered by the ESVD Bulletin Board which I hope will grow to form a vital and immediate means of communication between members both in Europe and in other parts of the world.

I wish you all a very active, prosperous and enjoyable dermatological year in 1992-93.

### MAKING CONTACT

Dial up the appropriate number e.g. for 2400 baud use 081-841-4114 (outside U.K. delete first 0 and add international code, 44). You will be connected to the computer. Give your name and allocate yourself a password. Contact the Sysop, to tell him you are an ESVD member and register.

### COST

The annual fee is £25, which goes to the operator, plus telephone charges. The latter need not be high if calls are made in off-peak hours and if messages are read 'off-line'. Software is available to do this.

## NEWS FROM THE NATIONAL ORGANIZATIONS

### BELGIUM

The Belgium Dermatology Group is doing well.

Following the 1991 elections, E. Fauvel was elected as President, J. Fontaine as Secretary, Isabelle Remy as Treasurer and Luc Beco the Deputy Secretary.

Papers produced for the Group on the subject of Dermatology are no longer published by the Group as we have too few readers. Instead, they are published in *The Veterinaria*, which is the Belgian Veterinary Media magazine.

The Luxembourg conference took up much of our time and energy in 1991, but now that this is over we are preparing for the National Veterinary Day at the end of the year.

We have initiated a membership drive to encourage young members of the Profession to join the Group, and we hope that the many initiatives that we propose will continue to stimulate the current level of interest.

### DENMARK

The main activity of the Danish Society of Veterinary Dermatology in 1991 was a two day seminar on canine and feline dermatology in March with Dr William H. Miller, Jr, New York, State College of Veterinary Medicine, Cornell University, Ithaca, New York, U.S.A. Many interesting aspects were covered including hypersensitivity, endocrine disorders, endocrine - impersonators -, keratinization defects and feline alopecias. Participants came from Germany, Denmark and Sweden. For the first time in Denmark, a parallel programme for Veterinary nurses was arranged, with members of the DSVD as speakers. This programme covered allergies of dogs and cats, skin biopsies and the use of medicated shampoos in dermatology. The meeting was attended by 80 veterinarians and 40 nurses.

The DSVD will arrange the 10th Anniversary Annual Congress of the ESVD in 1993, from August 27th-29th in the beautiful city of Aalborg. The planning of the Congress started in February, and is now well advanced insuring that this will be a memorable event with extensive scientific and social programmes. The social events will be geared for accompanying families, and the weather conditions in late August should be perfect for outdoor activities, for which the northern part of Jutland, where Aalborg is situated, is ideal.

### FRANCE

In 1991, the annual meeting of the GEDAC took place in Paris on 21st November, and was attended by 140 delegates. The main theme was dermatohistopathology presented by J.-P. Magnol and C. von Tscharner, and the topics included parasitic, mycotic and pustular dermatoses. During the afternoon a very interesting series of short communications were presented by the members.

For the pre-Congress day prior to the CNVSPA meeting, the GEDAC joined with the GEO (the oncology group of the CNVSPA) in presenting a programme devoted to cutaneous oncology. The speakers were D.N. Carlotti, P. Devauchelle, F. Delisle, J.-P. Magnol, C. Fournel and J.-F. Bardet.

The programme for 1992 includes two seminars at comprehensive level of 4 days each. The first was held in Lyon in March, and the second will be held in Bordeaux in October. The topics covered have (or will) include:

- I. The Dermatologic examination (Z. Alhaidari).
- II. Pyoderma (D.-N. Carlotti; Z. Alhaidari).
- III. Parasitic dermatoses (E. Guaguere).
- IV. Allergic dermatoses (E. Guaguere; D.-N. Carlotti).
- V. Hormonal dermatoses (B. Hubert; Y. Legeay).
- VI. Cutaneous oncology (J.-P. Magnol).

- VII. Pododermatitis (B. Hubert).
- VIII. Otitis externa (B. Hubert).
- IX. Dermatologic therapy (Y. Legeay).

The annual meeting of the GEDAC will take place in Paris on 20th November, 1992, during the CNVSPA meeting. The main themes will be dermatohistopathology and cutaneous cytology, and the speakers will be J.-P. Magnol, L. Ferrer, D.-N. Carlotti and C. Fournel. Clinical cases will also be presented by members in the afternoon.

### GERMANY

Veterinary dermatology continues to be quite active in Germany in 1991. There were two weekend meetings of the Veterinärdermatologie Arbeitskreises in Bad Kreuznach.

On Feb 23/24th Dr Bob Dunstan of Michigan State University, U.S.A. gave an excellent two day seminar which covered:

- Learning structure and function through congenital and acquired skin diseases of animals;
- Gross dermatopathology;
- Terminology of dermatopathology - understanding what the pathologist is really saying;
- Why do I get non-specific diagnoses when I submit perfect biopsies?
- Cutaneous oncology; what the pathologist can tell the clinician; and
- Patterns and controversies in dermatopathology.

On 16/17th November, Dr Valerie Fadok, from the National Jewish Hospital, Denver, Colorado, U.S.A. and Dr Ken Mason from Queensland, Australia joined forces in an outstanding programme which included both basic and clinical aspects of dermatology.

Dr Fadok discussed the pathophysiology of insect hypersensitivity in small animals and horses; basic aspects of immunology related to the skin; the immunopathogenesis of autoimmune diseases and the fascinating phenomenon of « apoptosis », or programmed cell death.

Dr Mason discussed drug eruptions, never thoughts on demodicosis, seborrhoeic dermatitis, and miscellaneous recent advances in veterinary dermatology. The presentations concluded with a discussion of the histopathology of the lichenoid tissue reaction.

Dr Koch gave presentations on allergic skin diseases in Baden-Baden, and on otitis externa at the Veterinary Faculty in Berlin, in Duisburg, Nuremberg, Bad Durkheim and in Hamburg, and on small animal dermatology at Koblenz.

Drs Koch and Peters gave presentations on autoimmune diseases and on the diagnostic approach to small animal dermatology at the annual meeting of the Fachgruppe für Kleintierkrankheiten in Stuttgart/Fellbach.

There will be a dermatology specialists session on Nov 5th, 1992, on a pre-congress day of the DVG annual congress. The speakers will be:

- Dr M. Suter, Cornell, U.S.A. (role of the skin as an immunologic organ: defense and allergy);  
Dr D. Walton-Angarano, Auburn, U.S.A. (atopy and food allergy; intradermal skin testing and immunotherapy);  
Dr C. Kalveram, Munster (differences in five skin test extracts of some producers);  
Dr R. Halliwell, Edinburgh, U.K. (insect hypersensitivity and drug eruption);  
Dr F. Kristensen, Frederiksberg, Denmark (contact allergy, and the biology of aeroallergens);  
Dr Otto Scheiner, Vienna, Austria, (recombinant allergens);  
Dr M. Schatz (diagnostic standards in human allergy);

The AIDEV held its first meeting in Vincenza on 11-12th April, 1992. Dr Vercelli spoke on hyperadrenocorticism in dogs, and Dr D.-N. Carlotti from France spoke on otitis externa, cytology of non-neoplastic lesions, nail diseases, biopsy indications and techniques and equine dermatology.

A further meeting will be held in Genova in October 1992 in cooperation with AIVPA. The main theme will be mycology in cats.

In June 1991 the Group held a pre-congress day in association with the SCIVAC meeting. The topic was oral diseases of cats. The final meeting which covered the second part of feline dermatology was held en Bresica in November 1991.

## SWEDEN

During the last four or five years, we, in Sweden, have had an informal dermatology study group called « The Skin Club », where veterinarians with a special interest in dermatology could meet and discuss cases in an informal manner. However in 1991 we felt the need to have a more official organization open to membership only by approval, and we created the Swedish Veterinary Dermatology Study Group (SVDG). Members must be willing to participate actively in meetings by contributing case reports, and already we have some 60 members.

The intention of the Board of SVDG is that two conferences will be arranged every year, one smaller informal meeting with case reports, and one more conventional meeting with invited dermatology specialists as speakers.

In May, 1991, a meeting was held in the Southern part of Sweden at the Castle of Snogeholm, near Ystad. Peter Ihrke and Thelma Lee Gross

were the speakers, and gave wonderfully coordinated presentations on clinical and dermatopathological aspects of dermatology. There were 55 attendees who heard their most instructive presentation, and we really learned about the diagnostic importance of skin biopsies.

In January, 1992, about 50 members met at a conference centre north of Hudiksvall, in the centre of Sweden, for a discussion of member's case presentations. There were many interesting reports, including the first reports in cats in Sweden of demodectosis, cryptococcosis and pox virus, and also of dermatomyositis in Shetland sheepdogs.

The programme for 1992 will also include an autumn conference with a speaker from abroad to which we will look forward.

## UNITED KINGDOM

The British Veterinary Dermatology Study Group held two meetings last year. The annual pre-BSAVA meeting was held at the International Conference Centre in Birmingham in April, 1991. Dr Ed. Rosser from Michigan State University, U.S.A., talked on castration-responsive dermatosis in the dog and canine food allergy. Dr Ken Mason from Queensland, Australia, talked about *Malassezia* dermatitis in dogs. Mr Ewan Ferguson gave an account of a geographic review of intradermal skin testing results in the UK.

The autumn meeting was held in November at Churchill College, Cambridge, and papers on thyroid testing in the dog, disorders of keratinisation in humans and pyoderma in bull terriers were amongst the excellent presentations. A new British Veterinary Dermatology Study Group Committee will be appointed in 1992, and it is anticipated that the Group will continue to publish bi-annual news-sheets and to hold two meetings each year. A news-letter containing the proceedings of the scientific meetings will be produced annually.

In addition, the occasional seminars in dermatology series run by Dr David Lloyd of the Dermatology Unit at the Royal Veterinary College continued with half-day seminars on the pruritic dog and cat (March 1991), scaling and crusting dermatoses (June, 1991) and on skin infections and their complications in dogs and cats (November, 1991).
