The year 2002 has been the first for Peter Hill as European Co-Editor of *Veterinary Dermatology*. Their wonderful work made it possible to raise the citation index from 0.658 to 0.934 and from position 45 to 30 in the ranking list of veterinary journals. ### ESVD Grant

ESVD wishes to encourage high standards in all aspects of veterinary dermatology and to promote the development of related research. Therefore, an annual research grant has been awarded since 1996 by the ESVD for basic or clinical research in veterinary dermatology. Each grant is to the value of 5,000 Euros.

Ordinarily projects are expected to be of one to two years' duration. Applicants are expected to propose a project of scientific merit that is applicable to veterinary dermatology. Grants are evaluated on scientific merit, feasibility, and usefulness. Preference will be given to novel proposals including the development of pilot studies. Applications for support of some identifiable component of an ongoing research work will also be considered. It is not the intention to provide funds for single items of capital expenditure.

Please note that the Society is not in a position to support the costs of institutional overheads. Any use of experimental animals must conform to the local ethical and animal welfare regulations.

Proposals should be received by April 1 each year for consideration by the grant awarding committee. Research proposals (four copies) should be sent to the current ESVD Publications and Grant secretary (Dr. Chiara Noli, Strada Madonna 58, 12016 Peveragno (CN), Italy). An acknowledgement will be sent. All applications will be subject to peer review and must include background information, project aims and objectives, project design, specific methods, budget together with an explanation of the relevance of the proposed work to veterinary dermatology, as described in the guidelines. The award will be granted and announced at the next AGM of the Society. Payment of the grant will be made into a special account and a budget report will be required by the ESVD Treasurer at the end of the study. Any funds not spent must be returned to the ESVD. Annual progress reports are required and should be submitted to the current Publications and Grant Secretary at least 30 days before the Society's AGM.

Successful applicants will be expected to submit their results for publication in *Veterinary Dermatology* and to present their findings to ESVD members at an ESVD Annual Congress within three years from receipt of the grant. The funds cannot be used for travel and accommodation at the meeting but only for research. However, the principal awardee is entitled to free registration at any ESVD Annual Congress at which he or she will present the data generated as a result of the grant.

Proposals should be prepared according to the following guidelines. As far as is practically possible, the proposals will be evaluated anonymously. Therefore, please include names, addresses and other identifying information only on the title page. Please make every effort to have no identifying information in the body of the proposal. Submitted along with the body of the proposal, as a separate document, should be one copy of the curriculum vitae of each of the principal investigators.

#### **Guidelines for Preparation of ESVD Grant Applications:**

Applications not adhering to these guidelines may be excluded from consideration. The number of pages listed are maximum numbers. Shorter proposals are acceptable and welcomed.

#### *Section 1 (one page maximum)*

Title page should include the project title, the name and title of the investigator, the institute at which the research will be performed, and the dates of the proposed project period.

#### *Section 2. (one page maximum)*

- Provide a brief abstract with clearly stated objectives and the importance of the research, the experimental design and the methods used for achieving the stated objectives.
- Specific aim(s): State in general terms the long term objective(s) and the hypothesis to be tested.

**Section 3 (2 pages maximum)**

**Background and significance:** In this section, briefly review the background for the present proposal, and the gaps in knowledge that the proposed project will fill.

**Section 4 (2 pages maximum)**

**Preliminary studies:** If there are preliminary data to support the hypothesis or to demonstrate that the investigator is familiar with the proposed methods, they should be included. If there are no preliminary results, then this section can be omitted.

**Section 5 (4 pages maximum)**

*i) Experimental design and methods:* This section should contain a concise discussion of the experimental design and the procedures to be used to accomplish the specific aims listed above. This section should be sufficiently detailed so that the feasibility may be judged. This section should list a brief description of resources available to investigators. It is important to discuss the means by which the data will be collected, analysed and interpreted, and the controls that will be required to allow a proper analysis. The type of statistical evaluation to be used for data analysis should be briefly detailed. Investigators should justify the sizes of experimental groups.

*ii) Animal use:* Projects must fulfil the requirements of legislation in force in the country in which the work is to be performed. A statement to this effect should be included in the application. Any project proposal involving animals must be evaluated by the applicant's institution animal use committee and a statement to that effect should also be included in the proposal. If pets are to be used in the project, a permission form for the owners to complete should be appended to the proposal. Unless animal care and use has been carefully addressed, a proposal can not be considered for funding.

**Section 6 (one page maximum)**

A one page detailed budget should be included. The ESVD will not subsidise professional veterinary fees incurred by clients in the investigation of animals involved in clinical projects.

**Section 7 (one page maximum)**

References should be provided for Section 3 (background information) and section 4 (methods).

## Minutes of the 18th AGM of the ESVD

---

Acropolis Centre, Nice - September 27th 2002

Margreet Vroom, President of ESVD opened the meeting, with a welcome to all.

### Treasurers Report (T. Whitbread)

Membership renewal will be featured in the next ESVD Bulletin.

There have been considerable delays in processing membership enquiries. This has been due in part to:

1. Resignation of the membership secretary,

2. Blackwells have been slow to post the journal *Veterinary Dermatology* after they have received notification.

They have had some changes in computer arrangements that have influenced posting of the journal.

3. Members are encouraged to notify change of address.

Members are encouraged to review their bank details when ESVD do not know the source of bank transfers to ESVD.

It is impossible in some cases to link a bank transfer to the name of a member.

Payment using VISA documents requires accurate placing of numbers in order to avoid delay in processing membership payments.

Some member's names were missing from the annual report due to secretarial mistakes – apologies offered.

From the floor one member suggested receiving a receipt that shows that payment has been received.

It is planned that with the new membership secretary that email acknowledgement will be sent out.

It would be feasible to send the Bulletin, Annual Report and other post to members by email and save ESVD a considerable amount of money (1500-2000 Euros per annum).

Members are advised that it may take 4 weeks to receive copies of *Veterinary Dermatology* once the membership payment/application has been received and processed.

### *Comments from the floor:*

ESVD is not registered as an organisation that is entitled to a tax deduction for membership fees in the UK – could this be considered?

Commercial companies may be willing to provide support towards the costs of mailing the bulletin to members.

A payment of 28,000 Euros has been made to the local organising committee for the ESVD annual meeting in Copenhagen (2001) – the financial report initiated discussion about the reasons for such a loss. Currently the scientific committee of the local organising committee will include members of the ESVD/ECVD boards. The ESVD board also reviews the budget for the annual meetings and offers advice. In order to avoid losses in future meetings the treasurers from the ESVD and ECVD boards will be seconded to the local organising committee to provide assistance.

### *Dr F. Kristensen offered the following comments as chair of the local organising committee in Copenhagen:*

The predicted delegate numbers included people from Eastern Europe who did not arrive, so instead of 700 delegates only 600 attended.

A Danish dermatology meeting that was held shortly before the congress, where attendance was free, exacerbated the situation.

A bill for printing costs was over 100% higher than the original quotation.

There are books in stock for nurses that are valued as 15,000 Euros to add back to the budget and 2 sponsor guarantees remain to be paid (total 23,000 Euros).

### *There was discussion about the registration fee for residents pursuing the alternative route for ECVD accreditation.*

The ESVD board had decided before the AGM to continue with free registration for residents; that undergraduate and postgraduate students in dermatology or related disciplines and alternative route residents should pay 50% of the registration fee. Factors to consider include the gradual decline in the number of delegates for annual congresses so that free registration may not be feasible in the future and all types of residents and postgraduate students may have to pay a fee or % of the registration fee for future meetings.

In view of the budget loss for the annual meeting in Copenhagen the board was invited to consider adoption of an insurance policy to enable local organising committees to avoid risk associated with budget losses – especially due to factors beyond their control.

The matters of limited liability, charitable and tax status of the ESVD, and how we can cover possible financial losses is are under consideration by the board.

#### **Membership Secretary Report (T. Whitbread)**

There were five applications for full membership and they were accepted on a vote.

T. Whitbread informed the meeting that there were 514 members of ESVD with an additional 90 that had not renewed so far. It was suggested that a web-based questionnaire survey could be sent to people that do not renew membership.

#### **Publications Report (C. Noli)**

##### *Veterinary Dermatology*

The citation index has risen from 0.658 to 0.934 in the past year and from position 45 to 30 in the list of veterinary journals.

Selected abstracts from the ACVD/AAVD and ESVD/ECVD annual meetings will be published from this year onwards.

Special issues are planned for the journal.

##### *Bulletin*

T Nuttall was thanked for his hard work on the bulletin.

##### *Web page*

This has been updated and will undergo further revision to make it more useful for members and to advertise the work of the ESVD.

D Lloyd was thanked for his part in assisting with the web page.

*Annual Report* Published this year.

#### **Further Education Committeeis Report (Z. Alhaidari)**

The next annual meeting will be held in Teneriffe and the final program will be confirmed in November 2002.

##### *Workshops:*

Therapeutics: 3-6th November 2003 Cremona Italy planned.

Skin biology: January 28-30th 2004, Lyons, Cancer Research Centre.

The membership is invited to suggest suitable venues for future annual meetings after Greece 2005 and for subjects for workshops.

#### **Research Committee Report and the Nomination of the ESVD Research Grant (C. Noli)**

The reviewers were unable to agree on the two applications submitted for funding.

Consequently the award will be postponed until 2003 and it may be possible to fund more than one project in the future.

##### **Any other business**

Those present adopted the ESVD bye-law changes, previously published in the bulletin.

There was considerable debate about how to commemorate the death of Ulli Renge Harms.

The ESVD board offered a free annual meeting registration for the recipient of an award that will seek to commemorate her death.

An agenda item for future meetings may include a detailed report, including financial details, of the annual meeting.

## INCOME

### **Membership Fee**

About two thirds of memberships are currently paying by Visa or cheques in Sterling and about a third paying by bank transfer. We have brought forward the renewal date to the 1st January for the year 2003 and some of the income therefore, for membership for 2003, is included in the 2002 accounts. After many years of trying to get prompt payment of membership, having 1st January as the deadline appears to have been a moderate success.

### **Investment Account**

Interest rate throughout Europe are low. We do accrue more interest on the Luxembourg Account compared to the UK Account but the bank charges for the general Luxembourg Account are far higher.

### **Annual Congress**

See below under expenses.

### **Blackwell**

The profits that are returned to us by Blackwell for sale of Veterinary Dermatology have increased quite markedly this year but some of this was catch up from quite a substantial number of late membership renewals in 2001.

## EXPENSES

### **Meeting and Travel Expenses**

We had two board meetings in 2002, both in Nice. The customary November board meeting was delayed to January 2003 and not included therefore in these accounts. Meeting and travel expenses continue on a downward trend.

### **Veterinary Dermatology**

This is actually less for the year 2002 but there will be some charges for a number of new members who joined late in the year and these will be in next years accounts.

### **Bank Charges**

Bank charges have been modest this year, the majority of these charges are associated with the Visa payments.

### **Secretary and Mailing**

This has reduced considerably this year and comprises 499.08 Euro for secretarial expenses and 389.42 Euro for postage. The postage included the flier for the Equine Workshop early in the year.

### **ESVD Publications**

This figure is principally associated with printing and transport costs of the printing. We have centralised printing in the UK and, in the latter half of the year, all printing was carried out close to the point of postage. This has considerably reduced the costs of transporting the printed material and we have also managed to get a better deal on the printing fees.

### **Congress Organisation**

The expenses under this heading are in fact the loss that was made at the Copenhagen Congress in 2001.

### **Miscellaneous**

This includes the yearly 100 Euro for our membership of Fecava and fees for maintaining our Web site which is, as you know, an ongoing cost.

### **ESVD Grant**

No grant was awarded for the year 2002.

#### **US Payment Account**

A small number of transactions have passed through this account, we now have a small balance in the US for payment of expenses to American Speakers.

#### **UK Bank Account**

There has been no mechanism to date for collecting Visa payments in Euros and storing them directly into Euros without passing through Sterling. We have an arrangement with the UK bank where we pay very little charge for this conversion but, as dealings in the Euro currency, even in the non Euro zone, are now becoming more stable there is a possibility that we may store all of our money in Euros in the future, possibly in one UK Account but this will depend upon the charges levied by the UK bank for dispersing Euro expenses.

#### **Dutch Account**

There is a small reserve in the Dutch Account which totals 2628.16c

#### **GENERAL COMMENTS**

First of all, we still maintain both a UK Sterling Account and a Luxembourg Euro Account and you will see that some of the totals that have been included as a starting balance do not correspond to the balances given in last years accounts. The reasons for this is that for the last few years we have maintained an exchange rate in the accounts of £1 equal to 1.6 Euro which has been roughly the exchange rate during that period of time. However, with the Euro strengthening and the pound weakening, the conversion has been made at £1 equal to 1.5 Euro and there is a high probability that this will decrease further during the year 2003.

I appreciate the concerted effort members have made this year to renew their subscriptions by the 1st January and I would encourage those members who are tardy in renewing their membership to renew early. This greatly increases the efficiency of administration and accounts to some extent for the reduction in secretarial charges. It also reduces out Visa charges and greatly helps with the general administration of the Society. I would encourage all members please to renew their membership before the beginning of January.

Costs to the Society of Veterinary Dermatology will be increasing over the next few years well ahead of inflation.

According to Blackwell, this is simply catch up from less than inflation charges in previous years but it will greatly increase our costs. Costs of running the Society, excluding the cost of Veterinary Dermatology Journal to each member, is less than 30 Euros. As you can see we have a very healthy balance at the present time but we would hope to not increase costs to members and to reduce this balance over the next few years as the establishment of a Limited Company for the board members will remove personal liability for losses of the board members and therefore remove the necessity for such a high balance.
